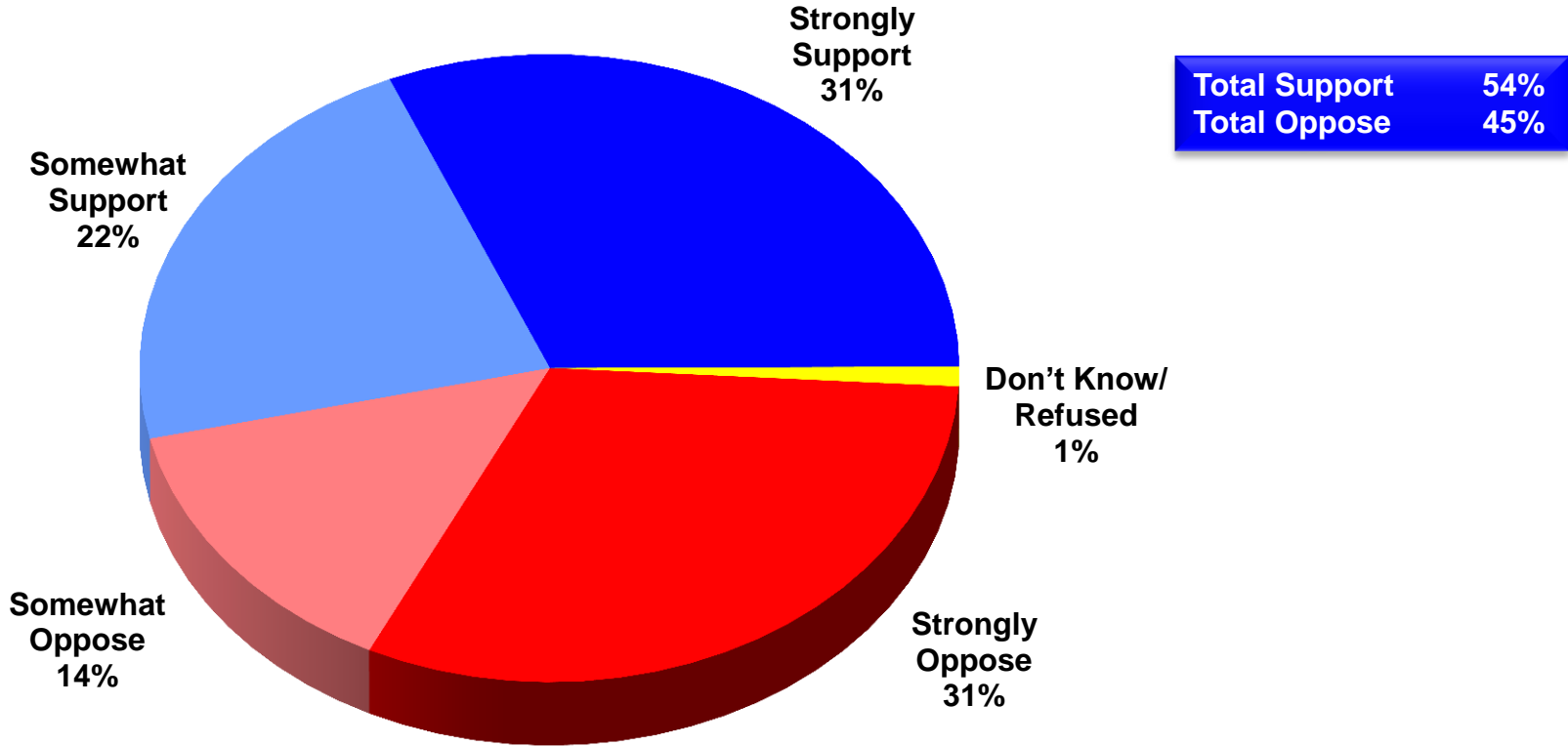
# Methodology

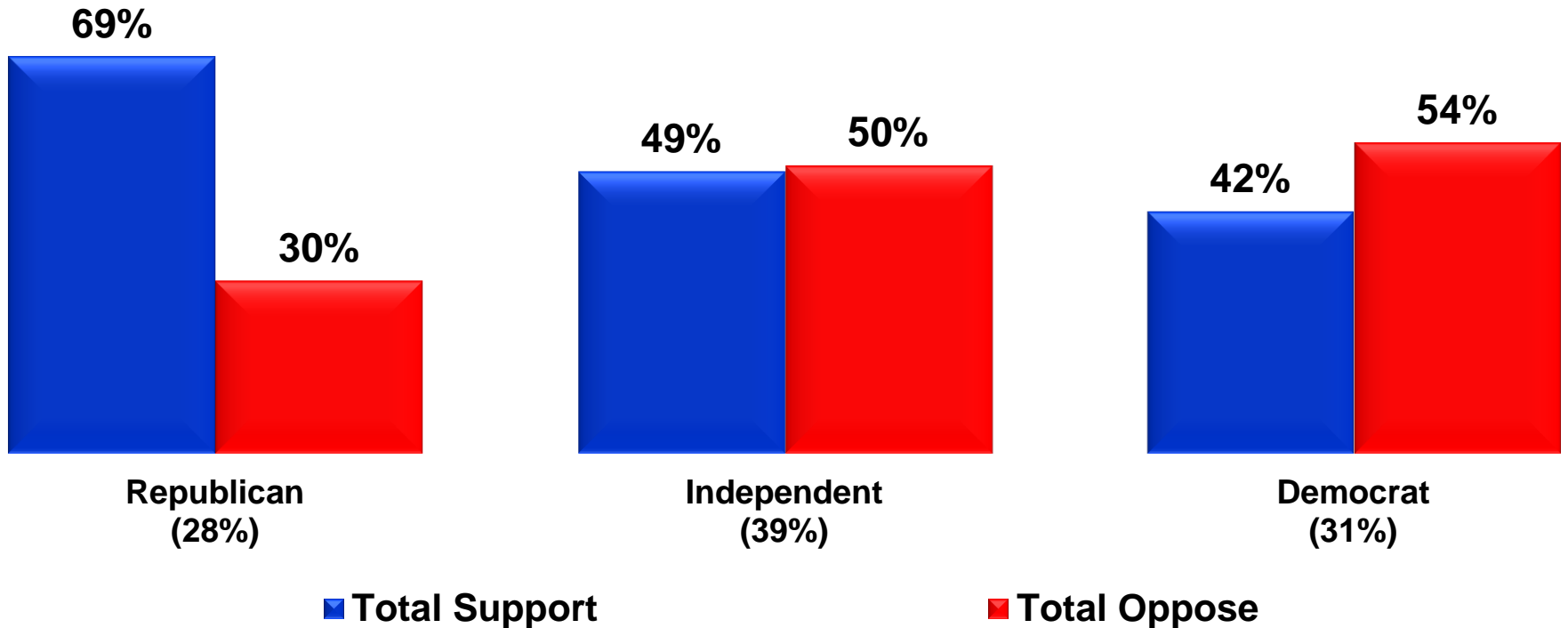

# Bipartisan support: A majority of republicans and 42% of Democrats support school choice.

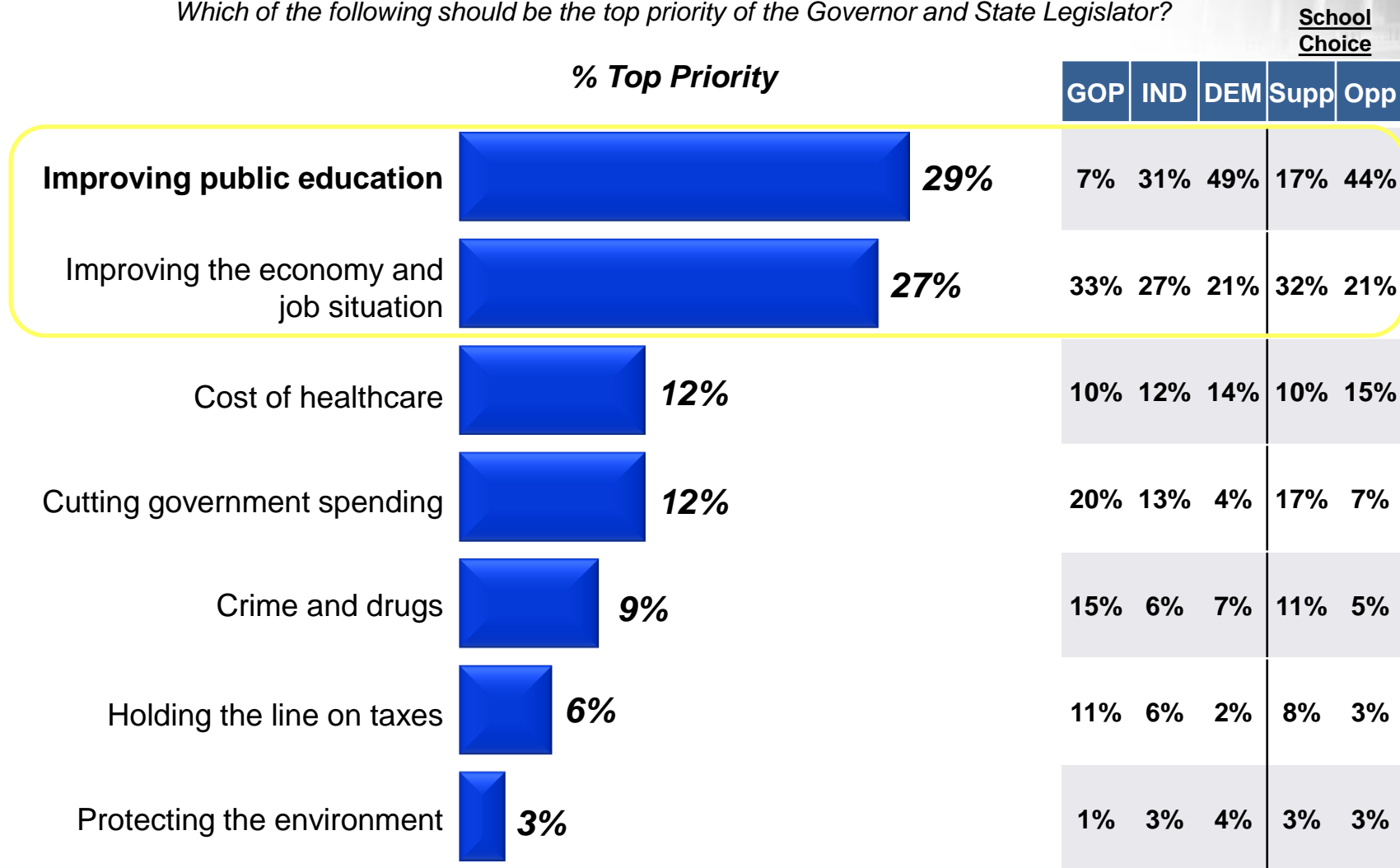
