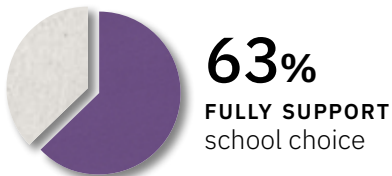


School Choice Polling Fact Sheet

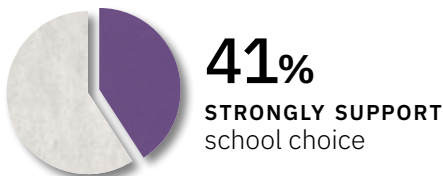
AFC POLLING

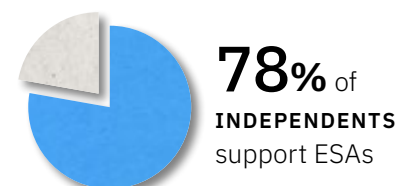
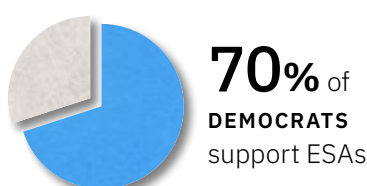
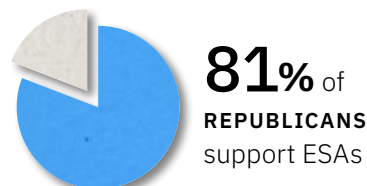
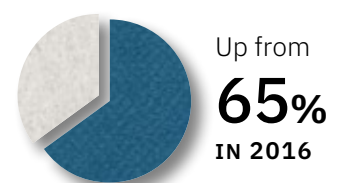
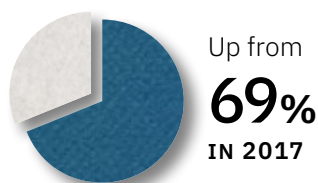
THE PRO-SCHOOL CHOICE COALITION IS DIVERSE:
