

O Bouche (segment begins 19:44): "the only letter I've ever written to a President of the United States is when Trump was elected back in 2016 I wrote him a letter, and I said, Mr. President, congratulations. Now, full disclosure, I was not a big Trump fan back then. I was very suspicious of him and his his background, the people you know. Out with sure I was, I was, I was more on leaning towards a conservative side, Ted Cruz, one of those I wanted. But with that being said, thank god Trump got elected. He's done an amazing job.



He's been a transformative figure in history, and that's that's been great. But the only letter I've ever written a president my entire lifetime was the one I wrote to him, and it said, Mr. President, congratulations. But if you don't fix election integrity in this country, we're dead. Nothing else matters. How prescient was that when you looked at what happened in 2020 so that's another big issue for me."

Bouche (comments begin 24:01): "I don't know enough about that, but I've always been really nervous about blockchain and about cryptocurrency. It's always, it's always seemed very Dungeons and Dragons to me, you know, like, Okay, I'm gonna mine this money.



Where'd it come from? Well, I mined it. Well, what, you know? What's that mean? It's money out of thin air. I think, I think that bubble is going to pop at some point."

- Host: "Well yeah with crypto, but I'm talking about blockchain being used to vote. I think, I think if we use blockchain, it couldn't be beat.
   I mean, there's no way."
- o Bouche: "How would you apply blockchain to that?"
- Host: "Well, it's very complicated, but everybody would be able to vote. That vote could be registered"
- o Bouche: "you'd have an audit trail."
- Host: "You'd have a complete audit.
- o Bouche: "Well, I would be in favor of whatever would"
- O Host: "not only that, but it could never be manipulated, because of the way blockchain set up. It's really, really, really brilliant. Could we apply it to voting? Is the key question. I think it would. Takes some computing power that, yeah, somebody have to pay millions of dollars to set that up"
- O Bouche: "But sometimes Hank sometimes the simplest answer is the best answer. I mean, in the countries where they have a thumbprint and you have to show up and vote in person on voting day, they have the least amount of fraud, yeah, you know, sometimes the simplest answer, I mean, there's ocular technology also, yeah, there's a lot of things you can do, but I think people are so suspicious of the government that they don't like giving a lot of personal information."

to make that, you know, easier for people to navigate at the same time. I am also in favor of when we catch somebody burning down our cities, destroying businesses that are contributing nothing to society, that hate America, loading them on the same bus that these people came in on, and sending them back south so they can experience what they want, the you want to live that life, then you should, you should go there and do that, right? So it's a citizens exchange program that we should, we should probably have. I mean, I want everybody here that wants to love and contribute and fight for this country to be here, you know? And there's a lot of people that are trying to come here legally that are caught up in the system right now, just because we're not efficient in the way that we process"



◆ Bouche wants to expand federal control of elections (something the democrats tried to push in 2023). While Bouche wanted tighter controls instead of the Democrats plans to disallow stricter voter ID requirements, turning everything over to the federal government when party control can shift is a dangerous game.

o Bouche (comments begin 33:57): "2020 was revealing. Also, if you watch what happened in Georgia. There was obvious fraud in Fulton County and everybody involved. I mean, people whistle blowing, saying, I saw it, I know it's there. And they said, Okay, we counted, you know, X amount of ballots. And you go, well, we want that



audited. And they fought you, and they fought you. And then you go back finally, and you say, Okay, we counted them again. That's the same number, but that's not an audit. An audit is you go look for how valid each ballot is. It's not you recount the fraud, fraud ballot. So I have another idea. What I'd like to see happen is these election administrators in each state should be held accountable for the evidence the entire I think we should pay them a lot of money, and we should make sure that there's a uniform practice for auditing election results in the states that refuse to follow federal law on how we you know, it says only US citizens can vote for those states. I don't think we should allow their votes to count on the federal level until until they comply with federal election law and. There should be a uniform audit process for all the states you go in. You have to be able to track all the ballots. The ones that you can't account for don't count, basically, until you can verify or contact the voter that cast them. There has to be a way to do that."




◆ Bouche "hopes" Israel turns Gaza to "glass" (comments at 59:41):
