Cell phones banned: All school districts must have a policy that prohibits students from using cell phones on school property during the school day. Previously, these policies were optional.

Ten Commandments on display: Every classroom must have a visible 16"x20" poster of the Ten Commandments on display.

Prayer time: School boards are required to vote on allowing designated times for prayer and Bible reading.

DEI banned: State DEI ban is now extended to public schools. This also bans the teaching of gender identity and sexual orientation.

Food additives banned: Certain food additives are banned from free or reduced school lunches and the breakfast program.
