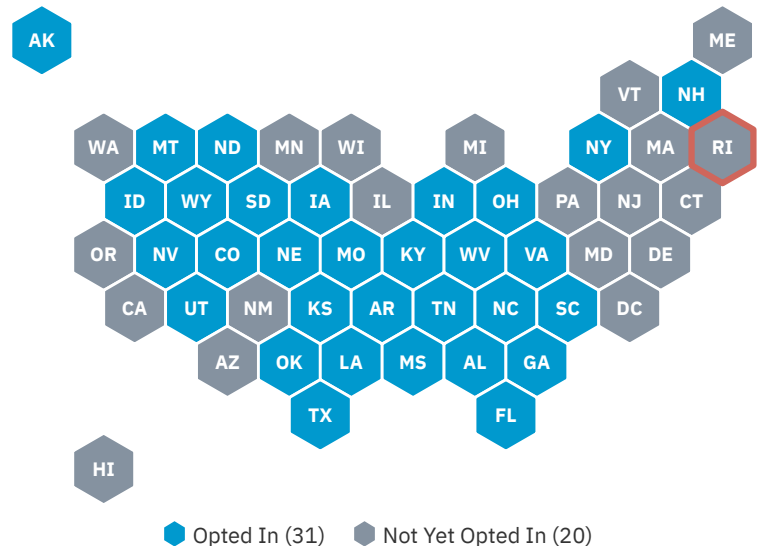
DONOR CLAIMS THE CREDIT

RHODE ISLAND BY THE NUMBERS

- **139,734 Rhode Island students are eligible** for EFTC scholarships.
- **Rhode Island has not yet opted in.** Its 139,734 eligible students can receive scholarships only if the state opts in.
- **The EFTC builds on the existing option.** Rhode Island families currently have a small private school choice program, and the Education Freedom Tax Credit would layer on an important new stream of scholarship support at no cost to the state budget.
- **Most families qualify.** The income limit is 300% of area median income, which averages about \$336,000 for a family of four in Rhode Island.
- **Students in public, private, and charter schools are eligible.**

WHICH STATES HAVE OPTED IN



SCHOLARSHIP DOLLARS FOR RHODE ISLAND STUDENTS

If Rhode Island taxpayers with \$1,700 of tax liability redirect the full credit to an SGO, the dollars add up fast:

\$28.6 million

in scholarships every year if **10%** of taxpayers with \$1,700
of tax liability participate

\$85.8 million

in scholarships every year if **30%** of taxpayers with \$1,700
of tax liability participate
