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Nickels is campaigning on capping property taxes and increasing property tax protections for the elderly as one of her top three issues...but Nickels did not even vote in the November 2025 constitutional amendment election that had several tax related propositions including increasing the homestead exemption to \$140k. _____ 13

In July 2026, Nickels gave her campaign website a full makeover. She now lists more campaign issues, or “priorities” notably eliminating any mention of property taxes. *Does Nickels no longer care about capping property taxes? Why did she remove them? Did she get a call?* _____ 18

Nickels was a Covid extremist who posted often and aggressively about the need to mask, vaccinate and stay at home. Nickels was incredibly condescending to anyone who disagreed with her and told them to “trust the science”. _____ 20

Nickels encouraged others to abandon their friends and family over different perspectives on Covid. Nickels wrote “People should ostracize their friends and family members until they get fully vaccinated” and unvaccinated people or those who refuse to wear a mask should face “consequences” and “not be allowed in civil society.” _____ 25

Downright unprofessional and unethical. Nickels showed complete animosity towards the “unvaccinated” even stating she had no empathy for her patients who were not vaccinated. She also implies that vaccination status should be a factor in whether you get ECMO or scarce medicines, meaning vaccinated people should be prioritized. _____ 26

Nickels called unvaccinated people “murderers” and, if you think she’s just being figurative, you’re wrong because she said, “literal murderers.” She even called to arrest the unvaccinated, asking “at what point do we start arresting the literal murderers?” _____ 27

Nickels supported vaccine mandates and forcing employers to make their workers get the jab. Nickels “welcome[d] with open arms” Biden’s draconian weaponization of Medicare funding

against nursing homes and hospitals who allowed employees to choose to vaccinate or not. _____ 28

Nickels called unvaccinated people “sociopaths” and told her friends to run far away from them: “Like I have said before, anti-vaxxers are sociopaths...If you have someone who is anti-vaxx in your life, you should run far away.” _____ 29

Was this assisted suicide? “A patient of mine died today. Tired of battling covid they told me they were tired. They wanted to die. They instructed me to take the bipap mask off and let them go.” Maybe this patient needed more encouragement. _____ 30

Nickels does not just work as a physician but also works in hospice. Nickels is also not afraid to withhold medication as she must avoid doing harm to people. What about the people in hospice who are in pain? If they are unvaccinated Nickels is “out of empathy” for them and they “no longer get [her] emotions.” _____ 31

In a selfie video, Nickels claims she is running for office for the sake of her children growing up in Texas and to improve healthcare in Texas. Nickels claims she has “a lot of expertise in healthcare policy” without going into details about any of her “ideas.” Strangely Nickels is almost whispering in the video, and her smoke detector is chirping in the background. ____ 33

A vaccinated patient died from Covid, and still Nickels blames it on the unvaccinated. ____ 35

Nickels didn’t like that she kept “seeing people post their post covid vaccine symptoms.” Nickels said, “I feel no pity for the privileged ones who got vaccines and are sick for a day.” 36

Nickels believes hospitals and nursing homes should force patients to die alone. Nickels was not happy with the passing of Texas House Bill 2211, which restricted the ability of hospitals to prohibit family members from visiting sick loved ones. Nickels wanted attending physicians to know they still had power to make it harder for people to visit their loved ones. _____ 37

Nickels donates to Planned Parenthood and portrayed a story of one of her patients who gave birth to a baby without kidneys who died shortly after birth. _____ 38

Nickels is endorsed by North East Bexar County Democrats and Blue Horizon Texas. _____ 39

Nickels is endorsed by Stonewall Democrats of San Antonio. The group describes itself as “the progressive political voice of the LGBTQIA community” and of supports the most egregious aspects of pro-LGBT politics, from gender transitioning kids to and exposing them to drag queens. _____ 41

Nickels states that her endorsement by the Planned Parenthood Texas Votes PAC relates to “keeping hospitals open, cancer prevention and real sex education in schools” _____ 46

Nickels posted a photo of herself and her husband showing the world that they support Black Lives Matter. _____ 47

Nickels posted several photos with James Talarico. The most recent on captioned “Our next senator”. Nickels in fear of facing backlash for the photo limited who was able to comment on it. _____ 48

Fully masked up, Nickels wants everyone to know she stands with Fauci. Does she still? ____ 50

Nickels is getting her news sources from Substack articles. Nickels posted an article titled, “MAGA Will Kill Many Americans.” The article accuses millions of voters and republican officials of pursuing policies out of greed and desire to cause premature deaths. _____ 51

Nickels posted a photo of herself and her husband with the pride flag filter. _____ 52

In a selfie video, Nickels discusses her Republican opponent’s new mailer. Nickels states she agrees with him about data centers and local wastewater issues but believes she caught him in a “gotcha” moment because the Republican states he is against “government regulation as one of his governing principles.” Nickels goes on to attack her opponent for supporting “civics and patriotism” in our schools, school choice and RFK Jr.’s MAHA movement. Nickels doesn’t understand the difference between burdensome government regulations on business and industry versus the government doing its job stewarding tax dollars correctly and protecting our natural resources. _____ 53

Nickels: “Data Centers are bad neighbors and can kill you.” Nickels was feeling under the weather so was her dog Tot who she mentions just got spayed...and that got her thinking about data centers. One of her biggest concerns is that data centers are too loud and will cause insomnia and cancer and they are not good for dogs. _____ 55

Nickels lists out why people should vote for her and how there needs to be more medical professionals in the Texas House. At the end of the video Nickels states “As the saying goes. How do you eat an elephant. One bite at a time but it sure is easier if we all bite together”. 57

Nickels posted that ICE agents should be prosecuted for murder. _____ 59

Nickels fears backlash and limits who can comment on her Facebook posts about data centers. In her rant Nickels said, “what if we could take that heat and store it to be used by the data center itself.” _____ 61

“what are the solution, Shelly?” Nickels asked herself before stating data centers should be built on decommissioned oil rigs. _____ 63

Nickels is upset about a wastewater treatment plant that will be allowed to discharge *treated* wastewater into Helotes Creek. _____ 64

As a doctor, Nickels has numerous bad reviews. One reviewer wrote of Nickels: “she thinks she’s gods gift to the world.” _____ 65

Nickels: “I believe Texas should expand Medicaid to improve access to care and reduce the financial burden on families and rural hospitals.” _____ 69

Nickels posted a video message to the “Physicians for a Healthy Democracy,” a leftwing group of “doctors” who oppose RFK, alternative medicine and vaccine freedom. In the video, Nickels attacks the GOP for “draconian policies,” pledges to “expand Medicaid” and bring “science” back to the classroom. _____ 70

Nickels boasts on her campaign website that she, “became the youngest medical director at Methodist Hospital, overseeing the largest hospitalist group for HCA at the largest hospital in Texas.” *If she’s running on her record at HCA, why doesn’t Nickels also mention that Methodist Hospital is #1 for net patient revenue in the for-profit hospital chain’s Texas network? Isn’t she proud of that?* _____ 73

Nickels: “We must restore women’s reproductive rights and reverse laws that have denied Texans access to necessary medical care, contributed to preventable maternal deaths, and driven OB-GYNs out of our state. I also support protecting the right to build a family through IVF and surrogacy and oppose efforts to restrict those options.” *Did robust support for surrogacy not poll well for Nickels – the term does not appear on her campaign website in the same issue statement.* _____ 76

Nickels: “Strong public schools are the foundation of a strong Texas. I support fully funding public education, investing in universal pre-K, paying teachers competitive salaries, and maintaining the separation of church and state in our public schools.” Nickels also says, “just because legislation was passed, this does not mean that is the way it must stay.” _____ 78

Nickels: “I support strong hate crime protections, common-sense gun safety measures, and policies that protect the rights, freedoms, and dignity of every person in our state.” _____ 80

Nickels reported a \$650 contribution from Texas Majority PAC. In August 2025, AG Paxton announced the George Soros-funded PAC was under investigation “for its role in potentially

unlawful financial coordination and bribery of Democratic legislators who fled Texas to break quorum.” _____ 81

Nickels agreed that the Texas border wall was a “waste of money” because in her mind you could “Yeah just like... walk around it” _____ 83

On her Personal Financial Statement, Nickels disclosed a liability to American Express of “at least \$56,610 or more” _____ 84

Nickels is campaigning on “accountability” but blocks who can comment on her campaign’s Facebook posts to hold her accountable. _____ 85

Is Nickels reporting all campaign expenditures in accordance with Texas law? Nickels paid someone on Venmo for “campaign expense” in June 2026 but reported no corresponding expenditure on her July 2026 semiannual report which would have covered activity in June. _____ 90

Nickels formed an LLC in February 2024 that had its tax status forfeited involuntarily in February 2026. _____ 92

Nickels’ husband works for Tyler Technologies. The company has major contracts with governments and agencies across Texas. _____ 97

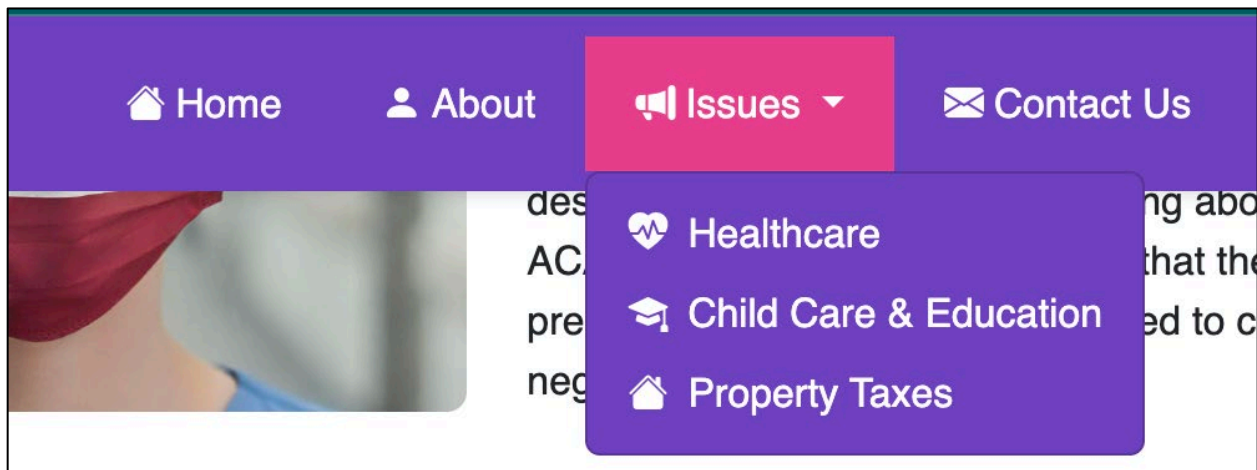

5. Reducing the burden of property taxes is expected to be a major focus of the next legislative session. Describe your ideas for balancing the needs of a growing state with state leaders' desire to rein in that major revenue source?

Reducing property taxes should be a major priority, but Texas must do it responsibly.

Relief should focus on primary residences, seniors, disabled Texans, veterans, and working families rather than providing the largest benefits to corporations, investors, and owners of multiple properties.

Large commercial property owners should not be able to use expensive litigation or distorted comparisons to shift more of the tax burden onto homeowners and small businesses.

Every major exemption or incentive should have measurable public benefits, regular audits, and an expiration date. Programs that do not create the promised jobs or investment should end.

Texas Secretary of State, Individual Vote Report

- ◆ There were **17 constitutional amendment propositions** in 2025; all **passed**, albeit by different percentages. Voters approved property tax cuts for homeowners and businesses; funding for water, higher education, and dementia research; tax credit/exemptions for veteran families, border security, animal feed and victims of house fires; as well as constitutional protections against capital gains and death taxes.
- ◆ Prop 13 raised the homestead exemption from \$100k to \$140k.

Proposition 13 – SJR 2

“The constitutional amendment to increase the amount of the exemption of residence homesteads from ad valorem taxation by a school district from \$100,000 to \$140,000.”

After another large increase in 2023, this amendment would again raise the resident homestead exemption for school districts. This has become a regular practice for the Legislature as property values and tax bills rise. For reference, in 2015 the homestead exemption was only \$15,000, with voters that year approving an increase to \$25,000.

Because of the way our schools are funded, schools do not lose money. This arrangement would swap local revenue for state revenue. As mentioned in Every Texan’s **testimony** on SB 4, the flat-dollar homestead exemption—in this case, \$140,000 off the taxable value of every homeowner’s residence—is the most equitable way to cut taxes for homeowners. It’s the same amount for everyone, regardless of their home’s value. Such a proposal, however, does nothing for renters, and with the big increases in the homestead exemption in recent years, it is important to carefully consider preserving revenue.

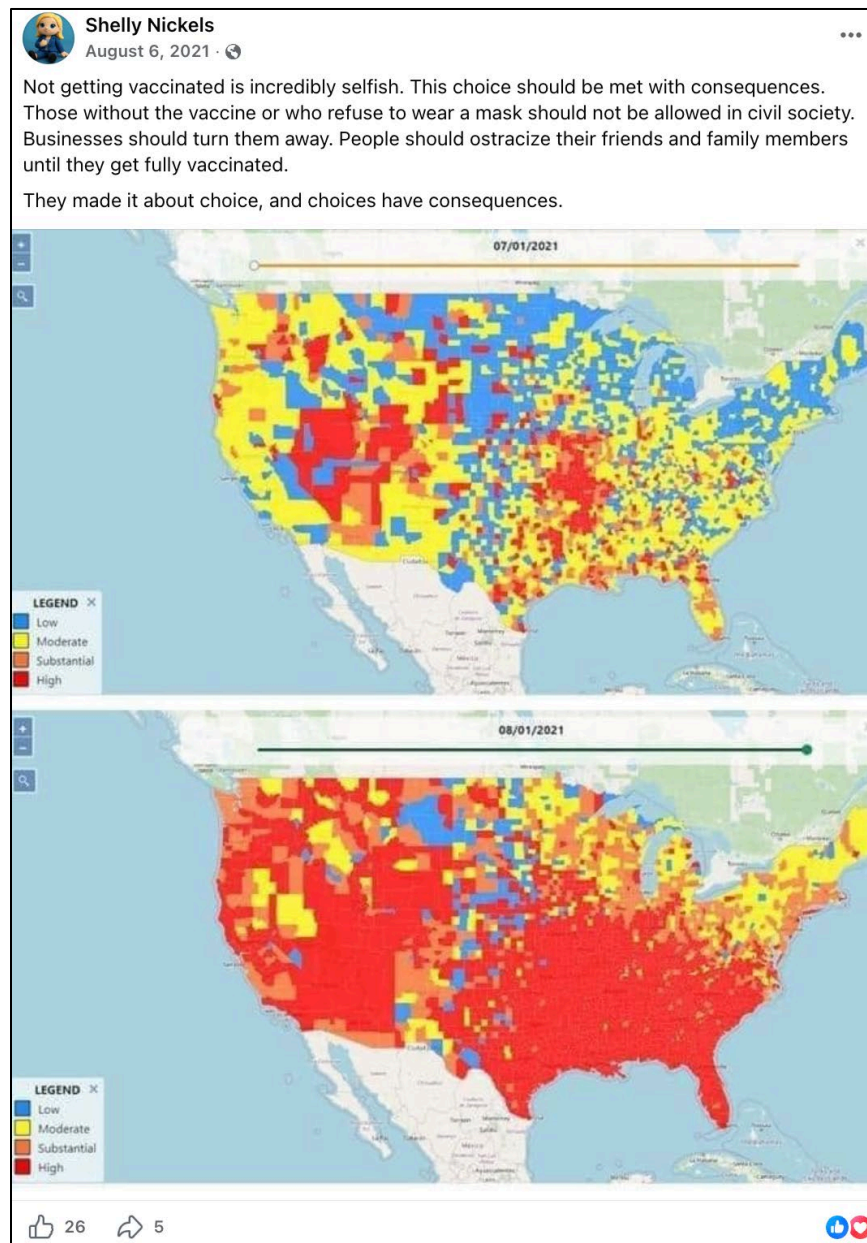

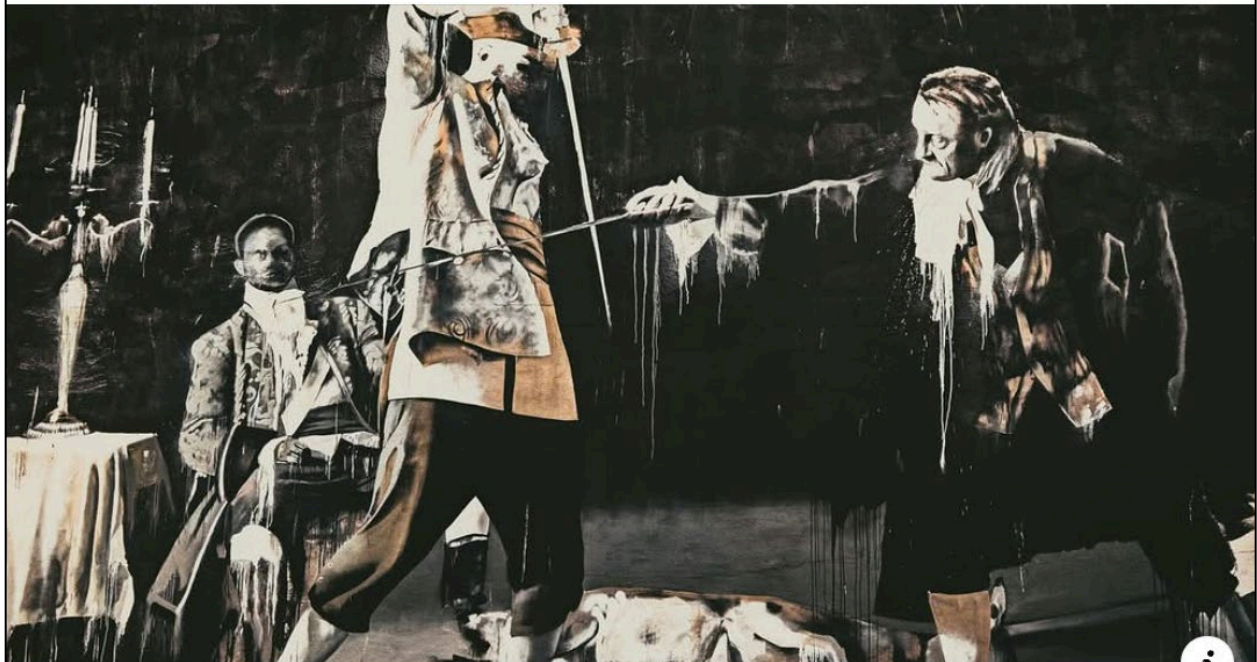

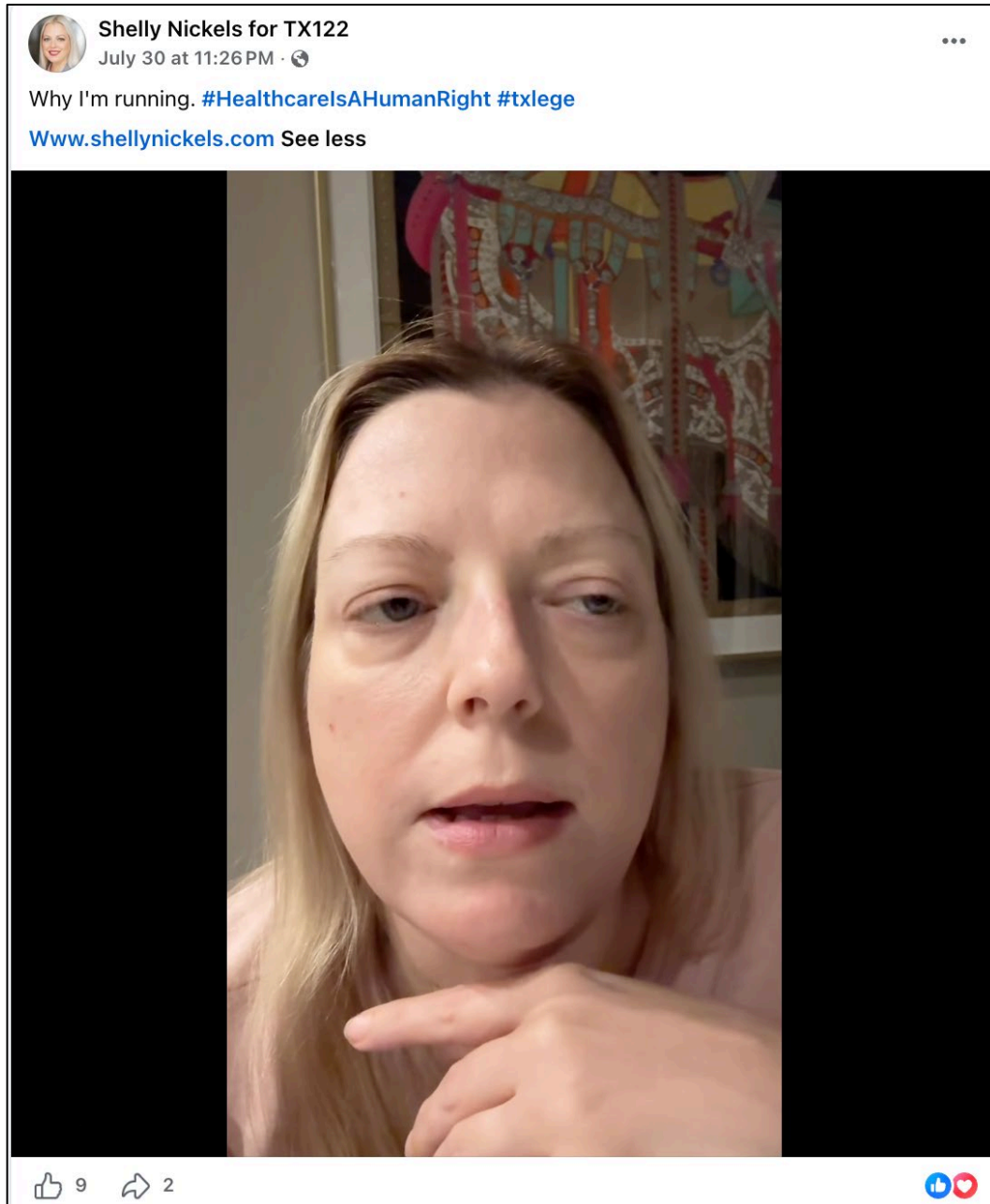

HHS Notice and Guidance on Gender Affirming Care, Civil Rights, and Patient Privacy

The Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) stands with transgender and gender nonconforming youth and their families—and the significant majority of expert medical associations—in unequivocally stating that gender affirming care for minors, when medically appropriate and necessary, improves their physical and mental health. Attempts to restrict, challenge, or falsely characterize this potentially lifesaving care as abuse is dangerous. Such attempts block parents from making critical health care decisions for their children, create a chilling effect on health care providers who are necessary to provide care for these youth, and ultimately negatively impact the health and well-being of transgender and gender nonconforming youth. The HHS Office for Civil Rights (OCR) will continue working to ensure that transgender and gender nonconforming youth are able to access health care free from the burden of discrimination. HHS understands that many families and health care providers are facing fear and concerns about attempts to portray gender affirming care as abuse. To help these families and providers navigate those concerns, HHS is providing additional information on federal civil rights protections and federal health privacy laws that apply to gender affirming care.

As a law enforcement agency, OCR is investigating and, where appropriate, enforcing Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act¹ cases involving discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity in accordance with all applicable law. This means that if people believe they have been discriminated against in a health program or activity that receives financial assistance from HHS, they can [file a complaint](#).

Federal Civil Rights Laws:

Parents or caregivers who believe their child has been denied health care, including gender affirming care, on the basis of that child's gender identity, may file a complaint with OCR.

Health care providers who believe that they are or have been unlawfully restricted from providing health care to a patient on the basis of that patient's gender identity may file a complaint with OCR.

OCR enforces federal civil rights laws that prohibit discriminatory restrictions on access to health care. Among these laws is [Section 1557](#), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, and disability in covered health programs or activities. OCR

Healthcare

As a physician this is the number one priority facing Texans. No one should have to go bankrupt due to unforeseen medical emergencies. No one should have to go without lifesaving medical care that they need such as cancer care. Shelly believes strongly in Medicare for the elderly, Medicaid for the disabled and CHIP for pregnant women and children. Medicare is an earned program. Americans deserve to have this without worrying about cuts when they paid into the system. Additionally, the ACA should provide subsidizes so that the working class can pay for insurance and not have their premiums doubled. Drug prices need to come down, and this should be done by being able to negotiate with drug companies.

Child Care and Education

Texans need more access to affordable childcare. Studies show that head start programs make students better prepared for school as well as having long term effects on economic self-sufficiency. This means higher earning workers for the future of Texas.



Property Taxes

Property taxes are going up every year in Texas. This leads to people not being able to afford to stay in their homes, especially as they age with incomes decreasing for the elderly. We need to place caps on property taxes.

I am Dr Shelly Nickels, MD, MHA. I am a native Texan, a doctor, a mom and a healthcare policy expert. I attended Trinity University for undergrad and for my master's degree in healthcare administration. I have worked for 12 years in San Antonio as a hospitalist and a medical director.

I attended medical school and residency in West Virginia during the height of the opioid crisis. I worked with senators in Washington DC through my local healthcare policy advocacy group to develop programs to curb the abuse and diversion of controlled substances.

I have three children under the age of 18 and as a working doctor and mom I know what it means to work hard. I know how to set my mind on a task and get the job done, even when it is really hard and takes a long time. I am a creative thinker and a strong believer in getting lots of people together to come up with solutions to hard problems.

Please list below 3 key messages of your campaign. What are the main points you want voters to remember about your goals for your time in office? ▾

- As a doctor running for healthcare as a human right in Texas, this means expanding Medicaid for children, the elderly in long term care and those with disabilities. This also means protecting reproductive rights for women and men, including access to IVF and surrogacy. We must negotiate and cap drug prices. Healthcare is unaffordable for many in our state and we must do everything we can to lower costs at every level and allow for real cost transparency and choices for patients.
 - We must insure that Texans have clean air, clean water and clean, reliable energy. In doing that we must regulate corporations to not pollute our natural resources and pay their fair share of taxes, lifting the burden off of households and small businesses in our community. We must also ensure that these billionaire owned corporations face accountability when they break the rules. We must ensure that the jobs that they create are given to Texans, not just the lowest bidder, and that they are good, safe jobs.
 - We need to provide every child a strong public school system which means funding pre-K. We must provide evidence-based comprehensive sex education at age appropriate levels.
- And we need to ensure that not another single dollar is given to vouchers which have been shown to be a handout to wealthy families at the expense of our public schools.
- Public schools are a way out of poverty for so many and we need to hold every school that receives public money accountable for our future.

What areas of public policy are you personally passionate about? ▾

Healthcare! It affects everyone regardless of party. It is also huge that people feel that there is nothing to be done.

The reality is that there are so many things that can be done RIGHT NOW and then so much more once we reach some stabilization and sanity. Shelley Nickels is a physician who works as a medical director at Methodist Hospital.

1. Please tell voters about yourself.

I am a native Texan, an internal medicine physician, and the proud mother of three children. For the past 12 years, I have cared for patients in San Antonio, serving as a medical director for hospital medicine programs. I earned my undergraduate degree and later a Master's in Healthcare Administration through Trinity University's executive program, where I also met my husband, Eric.

I decided to run for the Texas House because too many Texans are losing access to affordable health care or facing dramatically higher costs. As a physician, I understand why our health care system is failing patients and providers alike. Texas needs leaders with real-world expertise who can develop practical solutions, and I believe our Legislature would benefit from having more health care professionals at the table.

2. Briefly describe your top policy priorities.

I believe Texas should expand Medicaid to improve access to care and reduce the financial burden on families and rural hospitals.

We must restore women's reproductive rights and reverse laws that have denied Texans access to necessary medical care, contributed to preventable maternal deaths, and driven OB-GYNs out of our state. I also support protecting the right to build a family through IVF and surrogacy and oppose efforts to restrict those options.

We should use the state's purchasing power to negotiate lower prescription drug prices and reduce out-of-pocket costs for patients.

Strong public schools are the foundation of a strong Texas. I support fully funding public education, investing in universal pre-K, paying teachers competitive salaries, and maintaining the separation of church and state in our public schools.

Texas should protect our clean air, clean water, and electric grid while ensuring large corporations contribute their fair share and create opportunities for Texas workers.

Finally, every Texan deserves to feel safe and respected. I support strong hate crime protections, common-sense gun safety measures, and policies that protect the rights, freedoms, and dignity of every person in our state.

3. What would you like to see the legislature do to make Texas cities better places to live? In what ways could state officials work better with local officials?

I believe the Legislature should treat Texas cities as partners, not adversaries. Every community faces different challenges, and local leaders are usually in the best position to understand the needs of their residents. The state's role should be to provide resources, set high standards, and ensure accountability.

We need to increase the supply of affordable housing for working families, teachers, first responders, veterans, and seniors.

We need to protect our water resources, modernize the electric grid, and ensure that large industrial users, including data centers, contribute fairly to the infrastructure. We need to support law enforcement with training and resources while expanding mental health services, crisis intervention, and diversion courts that reduce repeat offenses and improve community safety.

4. Texas has taken major steps to reshape its public education system, including allowing taxpayer dollars to fund private school tuition. What do you believe needs to happen to monitor the success of Education Savings Accounts, and to ensure every student still receives a quality education?

Texas should fully fund public education, oppose vouchers that drain neighborhood schools, and ensure all publicly funded schools are held to the same standards of accountability. Just because legislation was passed, this does not mean that is the way it must stay. We must undo this harmful legislation that primarily benefits those who were already attending and could already afford private school education at the expense of our public schools.

5. Reducing the burden of property taxes is expected to be a major focus of the next legislative session. Describe your ideas for balancing the needs of a growing state with state leaders' desire to rein in that major revenue source?

Reducing property taxes should be a major priority, but Texas must do it responsibly.

Relief should focus on primary residences, seniors, disabled Texans, veterans, and working families rather than providing the largest benefits to corporations, investors, and owners of multiple properties.

Large commercial property owners should not be able to use expensive litigation or distorted comparisons to shift more of the tax burden onto homeowners and small businesses.

Every major exemption or incentive should have measurable public benefits, regular audits, and an expiration date. Programs that do not create the promised jobs or investment should end.

Texas should use its broad statewide revenue base to permanently reduce school district tax rates while fully replacing the lost local revenue.

Taxpayers should receive clear information showing which taxing entities increased or decreased their rates, how their bill was calculated, and how to challenge an inaccurate appraisal.

Texas should not pay for relief through excessive sales taxes, fees, or other regressive measures that simply move the burden from one household bill to another.
